

COVID-19 RISK ASSESSMENT

Sunday Shake Up at Rolleston Primary School

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Hazard Description	Who is at risk?	Mitigations
Spread of virus by unknowingly asymptomatic attenders	Those attending Shake up and their household	Leaders will be wearing face coverings unless there is a specific need for them not to, for example if they are leading from the front and are a minimum of 2m away from all the attendees. Face coverings will not routinely be worn when outside. Physical contact will be discouraged, for example hugging and high fives.
Someone attending Shake up may later test positive for Covid19	Those attending Shake up	Anyone with Covid-19 symptoms should not attend shake up and everyone attending will have been booked on via the online booking system for Sunday morning services. If anyone who attends shake up or a member of their household receives a positive test they must inform Avenue Church through the standard process for Sunday morning gatherings.
Toilets and frequent contact points such as door handles	All who use the building	Toilets will be cleaned before and after each group by the group leaders. Only one child will be able to use each toilet at any one time.
Ventilation	Those attending Shake up	The large sports hall will be utilised for Shake up. Which allows plenty of space for air circulation, ventilation and social distancing. Doors will also be propped open where possible to do so.

Crowding at entry and exit points	Those attending Shake Up and their parents / guardians	Different doors will be used for entry and exit. Children will be encouraged to socially distance while entering and leaving. Children will be taken back to their parents either in the main hall or in the playground area.
Crowding during drop off and pick up times	Those attending Shake up	Parents are able to bring their children to the main sports hall door when dropping off and will receive their children back in the main hall or the playground area.
Youth group games normally involve physical contact	Those attending Shake up	Games played at youth groups will not promote physical contact. Children will be spread out for activities involving singing or speaking loudly.
Building capacity and social distancing	Those attending Shake up	Due to building capacity a maximum of 36 people including leaders will attend each shake up if it is indoors. There is no limit to numbers outdoors.
