
The Doctrine of the Trinity: What It Is & Why It Matters

The Nicene Creed (325/381 AD)

We believe in one God, the Father, the Almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all that is, seen and unseen.

We believe in **one Lord, Jesus Christ, the only Son of God**, eternally begotten of the Father, God from God, Light from Light, true God from true God, begotten, not made, of one Being [homoousion NOT homoiousion] with the Father; through him all things were made.

O Come All Ye Faithful

God of God, Light of Light Lo, He abhors not the Virgin's womb Very God Begotten, not created

For us and for our salvation he came down from heaven, was incarnate from the Holy Spirit and the Virgin Mary and was made man. For our sake he was crucified under Pontius Pilate; he suffered death and was buried. On the third day he rose again in accordance with the Scriptures; he ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead, and his kingdom will have no end.

We believe in **the Holy Spirit**, the Lord, the giver of life, who proceeds from the Father (and the Son) [filioque], who with the Father and the Son is worshipped and glorified, who has spoken through the prophets. We believe in one holy catholic and apostolic Church. We acknowledge one baptism for the forgiveness of sins. We look for the resurrection of the dead, and the life of the world to come. Amen.

THE DEITY OF JESUS CHRIST: H.A.N.D.S Acronym

Honors = Jesus shares the honors due to God.

Attributes = Jesus shares the attributes of God.

Names = Jesus shares the names of God.

Deeds = Jesus shares in the deeds that God does.

Seat = Jesus shares the seat of God's throne.



HS Spirit - impersonal


SABELLIANISM



Modalistic — unorthodox belief that the one God existed in three modes at different times in history but never at the same time. Often they believe God's name is Jesus.






The Three Gods

The Trinity Error Triangle


